Privacy notice for SCiP Alliance online events

This notice sets out how we will collect, use, and protect your data in connection with online events.

When you register to participate in a SCiP Alliance online event we will collect certain data about you:

- Your name
- Your job title
- Your employer/organisation (where applicable)
- Your email address
- Your work telephone number

This will be used in order to administer your participation in the online event and therefore to fulfil our agreement with you. These details will be stored on a secure limited access system and will be deleted no later than three months following the event.

We will not share your data with any other organisation, nor will we use it for any other purpose.

Where we use Zoom as our platform for delivering online events you will be asked to provide to Zoom Video Communications Inc. your name and your email address. For this element of the process please refer to Zoom's privacy policy at https://zoom.us/privacy.

We plan to make a recording of the event available via YouTube or a similar public platform following the event. Recordings will not include the voices and faces of any participants other than the presenters. If you are a presenter then your face and voice will be included in recorded versions of the event.

Where our online events include text-based chat functions we will use the transcripts of these chats only to ensure the functioning of the event (e.g. to facilitate question and answer sessions). Anonymised versions of chat transcripts may be stored in order to inform the SCiP Alliance's future work.

You have certain rights regarding the use of your data. You have the right to: obtain a copy of the personal data we hold about you; ensure that data is correct; have that data deleted; the portability of your data; and object to how we are processing your data.
